THE RED RIVER PARISH POLICE JURY met on Wednesday August 4, 2024, at 10:00 am in its Committee/Regular meeting in the Police Jury Assembly Room, located in the Red River Parish Courthouse, Coushatta, La in its Regular meeting with Vice- President Taylor presiding. Roll Call and attendance was recorded as follows:

Invocation by Mr. Hillman and pledge by Mr. Young

Expansion

On the motion of Mr. Moore, seconded by Mr. Young the agenda was expanded to discussion the Westdale Plantation Bridge. Motion carried on the expansion of the agenda.

With Mr. Moore making another motion followed with a second by Mr. Young it was decided to give Mr. Davis the authority to do whatever necessary dealing with the Lawyers on the Westdale Plantation Bridge. Motion Carried.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED that the following millage(s) are hereby levied on the 2024 tax roll on all property subject to taxation by Red River Parish Police Jury.

PARISH TAX: GENERAL ALIMONY	4.41
PARISH TAX: EXEMPTED MUNICIPALITIES	2.20
RED RIVER PARISH LIBRARY	8.13
RED RIVER PARISH HEALTH UNIT	2.42
RED RIVER PARISH POLICE JURY PFMF	3.63
RED RIVER PARISH COUNCIL ON AGING	1.15

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proper administrative officials of the Parish of Red River, State of Louisiana, be and they are hereby empowered, authorized, and directed to spread said taxes, as hereinabove set forth, upon the assessment roll of said Parish for the year 2024, and to make the collection of the taxes imposed for and on behalf of the taxing authority, according to law, and that the taxes herein levied shall become a permanent lien and privilege on all property subject to taxation as herein set forth, and collection thereof shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law.

The foregoing resolution was read in full; the roll was called on the adoption thereof, and the resolution was adopted by the following votes:
