### Roads

Mr. Woodard gave the CVU report, it was discussed again to look at the price of the permits, and on the motion of Mr. Davis seconded by Mr. Moore it was agreed to advertise the new prices for road usage permits. Motion Carried.

### Expansion

On the motion of Mr. Hillman, followed with a second by Mr. Hillman, the agenda was expanded for the Swift Fiber representative to discuss what permits are needed to begin their project of laying fiber optics for internet service and for Ms. Palmer to discuss having a family Event at the Fairgrounds called the Southern Group Fest 2025
