

Minutes of the Meeting Of the

Red River Parish Police Jury held on the 3rd DAY OF DECEMBER 2025

THE RED RIVER PARISH POLICE JURY met on Wednesday, December 3, 2025, at 10:00 am., in the Police Jury Assembly Room, located in the Red River Parish Courthouse, Coushatta, La in its regular meeting with President Murray presiding. Roll Call and attendance were recorded as follows:

Invocation by Mr. Taylor, and pledge by Mr. Murray

Roads

Mr. Sam Carter gave the road permit report. Nothing voted on.

New Business

On the motion of Mr. Taylor seconded by Mr. Brown, the minutes for November 2025 were approved. Motion carried.

With Mr. Moore making the motion followed with a second by Mr. Taylor the Administrative staff was reappointed for two years. Mr. Davis abstained from voting. Motion Carried.

On the motion of Mr. Davis seconded by Mr. Moore it was approved that the Police Jury employees work a staggered schedule for the holiday and add the day after Christmas and New Year a holiday per State schedule. Motion Carried.

Mr. Taylor made the motion followed by second from Mr. Moore, Dori Ammons was reappointed as secondary Assistant Coroner for Red River Parish, when Dana Moseley is not available, for a period of two years starting January 1, 2026, to January 1, 2028. Motion Carried.

On the motion of Mr. Taylor, followed with a second by Mr. Brown, a resolution canvassing the return and declaring the result of the special election held in the parish of Red River on Saturday November 15, 2025, was adopted. Roll Call: 7 Yeas 0 Nays 0 Absent. Motion Carried.

With Mr. Taylor making the motion followed by a second by Moore it was agreed that the Jury give Mr. Davis Authority to sign the Intergovernmental agreement construction contract with the River Red Parish Sheriff. Motion Carried.

Mr. Moore made a motion followed by a second by Mr. Brown, Dr. Virginia Webb was appointed to the Library Board of Control to replace Ms. Laurie Jones who stepped down from the board November 1, 2025. The appointment will be for a 5-year term beginning January 2026 to January 2031. Motion Carried.

On the motion of Mr. Moore seconded by Mr. Brown the following beer/liquor licenses were approved for 2026:

On the motion of Mr. Taylor seconded by Mr. Brown it was approved to pay the bills for the month of November 2025. Motion Carried.

With Mr. Moore making the motion followed with a second by Mr. Taylor, authority was given to Mr. Davis to move some funds into a LAMP investment account. Motion Carried.

Budget was discussed, nothing voted on.

It was announced that the Budget hearing to adopt the proposed 2026 budget was set for January 7, 2026, at 10 am in the Police Jury meeting room.

Ambulance

With Mr. Taylor making a motion followed a second by Mr. Young, the Ambulance District bills were approved to be paid for the month of November 2025. Motion Carried.

On the motion of Mr. Moore Motion seconded by Mr. Brown the meeting was adjourned. Motion Carried.
